Career Bingo

TEACHER GUIDE

Overview

In this activity students review what they know about science- and math-related careers. Students play bingo with cards having the names of the mission careers in the squares. As the teacher reads a career description or task, the students must recognize the career and place their chip in the appropriate square. The first student or student team to complete a line down, across, or diagonally wins.

Note: This activity should follow the other career exploration activities so students have familiarity with these careers.

Materials

- Copies of career bingo cards
- Bingo chips (or any other placeholder, such as colored pieces of paper or paper clips)
- Career descriptions

Procedure

- 1. Decide the game grouping. Your students can play career bingo individually or in teams.
- 2. Distribute the bingo cards and chips and review the directions with the students.
- 3. Allow enough time for the students to write the remaining careers in the squares.
- 4. Choose a career description at random from the list (next page and following). Read this aloud to the class and place a checkmark next to the item so you can remember what you have already read.
- 5. Direct the students to identify the career and to place their chip on the appropriate square.
- 6. Repeat the process for other careers.

- 7. The first student or student team with a complete line down, across, or diagonally wins.
- 8. Check the card for accuracy.
