Teachers Answers for Electrical Current Creates A Magnetic Field

Part I

- 1. A magnetic field is created when the circuit is complete. Iron filings will react to this field by forming an oval pattern around the magnetic field. The filings will "stand up".
- 2. The magnetic field is strongest nearest the nail when the circuit is complete. The magnetic field becomes weaker, the further away you move form the nail and the completed circuit

Part 2: Exploring the magnetic effect of various electrical currents

1. As the power supply strengthens, the magnetic field becomes stronger.

1. Increasing the power source will increase the electrical current flowing through the wire and therefore create a stronger magnetic field.
